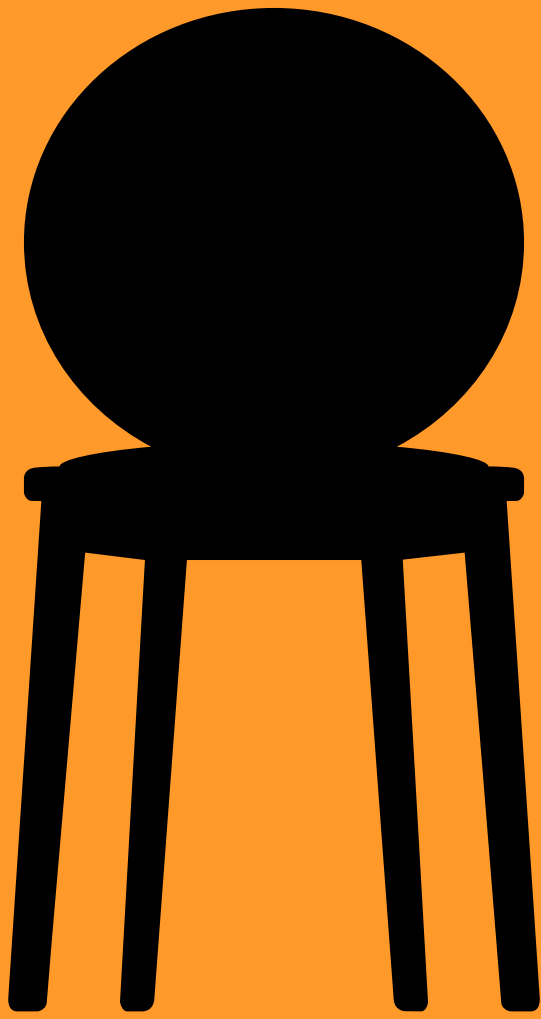

Care instructions Tranquebar chairs and stools

Proper caring for your furniture prolongs its beauty for years to come.

Oiled wood

Use a clean, dry cloth. We do not recommend using wet cloths on oil treated surfaces. If spots cannot be removed with a dry cloth, use a cloth soaked in clean water and wrung well. After, firmly wipe the surface in the direction of the grain with a dry cloth.

Upholstery fabric

Dust and dirt wear down the textile and reduce its fire-retardant properties. Avoid long-term exposure to direct sunlight and other light sources as the textile might inevitably fade. Frequent vacuum cleaning with a soft fitting is recommended to preserve the color and appearance of the textile.

Stain removal

Prevent stains by rapidly caring for the spill. We cannot guarantee complete stain removal. First, scrape off any liquids or hardened residues with a spoon or a scoop before you proceed. Any loose particles must be vacuum cleaned before further cleaning. Liquids must be soaked up with an absorbent napkin or cloth.

Remove non-greasy stains by carefully dabbing with a lint free cloth or sponge wrung out in warm water. Edge marks can be avoided by dabbing gently in circular motions towards the center of the stain with a clean lint free cloth. Remove greasy stains with appropriate detergents or solvents. In all cases, we recommend testing stain-removal agents on an inconspicuous area first. Make sure the fabric is fully dry before use.

The above mentioned suggestions are purely recommendations and cannot guarantee complete stain removal.

In order to ensure satisfactory results, particularly for large stains, we recommend contacting a professional dry cleaner. It is important to state whether the stain has already undergone treatment.

Due to excess dye in jeans, dark jeans may leave stains on textiles; washing and cleaning may not always lead to satisfying results.

Warning: Do not rub the material hard because this could result in loss of colour or potential damage to the nap.

Pressure marks

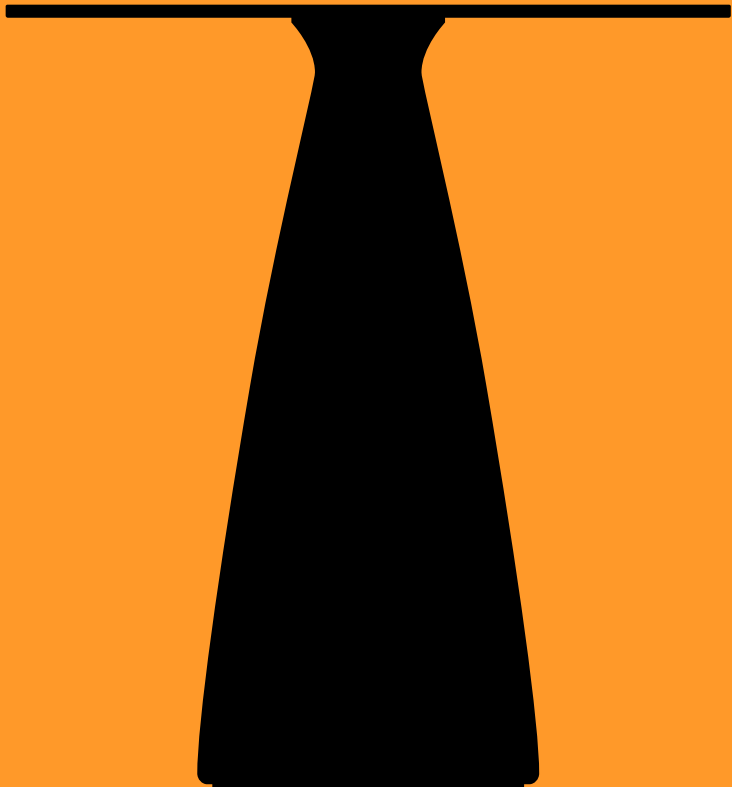
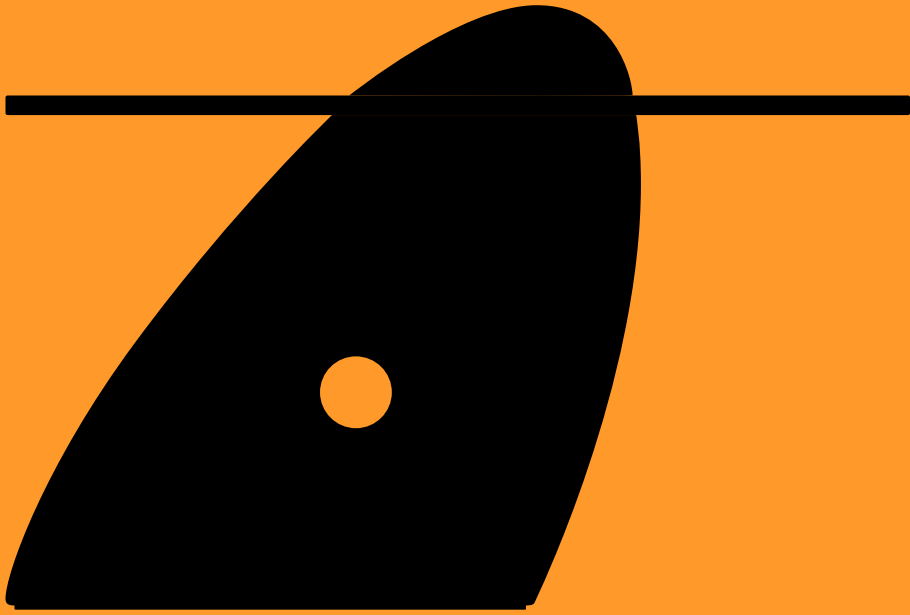
Pressure marks may appear during use, forcing the nap in different directions, which is noticeable through a change of colour. This effect is due to a combination of rising air humidity, body moisture and weight.

Treatment of pressure marks

It is possible to remove creases and pressure marks by placing a damp cloth on the textile or spraying with clean water until the textile's surface is moist, but not wet.

The same result can be achieved by carefully steaming the textile with an iron at a distance of 1 – 2 cm from the surface. Avoid exerting pressure on the textile. Brush the textile with a soft brush for the nap to rise to its original state. Let the textile dry overnight.

In order to avoid shading, we recommend treating the complete surface accordingly. If it is not possible to let the textile dry naturally overnight, it is possible to use a hair dryer from different directions to rise the nap to its original state.



Care instructions Tranquebar Granite Table with Glass Top

Granite

Black granite is a hard-wearing, long-lasting stone with a natural varying colour and structure, thus making each piece unique with some variations in the pattern. There may be sand holes, glass veins and porosities in the surface, all of which occurs naturally and is part of the individual character of the product. Variations in the stone are not accepted as a cause of complaint.

The granite is hand carved and brushed with natural coconut oil. As the oil is absorbed into the stone, it transforms from a light grey to black. However, over time due to exposure to direct sunlight, humidity and climatic conditions, the stone will dry and turn back to the original colour. Natural oil can be reapplied to the carved stone using a small stiff brush. As the oil is absorbed into the stone, the stone will turn black again. Remove any excess oil with a dry cloth and leave to dry.

Care

For maintenance, use care products specially developed for granite or use a damp cloth wrung in a mix of water and mild soap or soap flakes. This will form a light protective film on the surface.

Cleaning

We recommend cleaning with a damp cloth wrung in a mix of water and mild soap or soap flakes. Granite tolerates most cleaning products.

Glass Table Top

Care

Be careful with sharp objects as they may scratch the surface.

Cleaning

Tabletops made of glass should be wiped with a clean, dry cloth. To remove grease, use a glass cleanser. Excess water can be removed with a dry cloth and dry polished with a microfiber cloth.
